To Be Determined at the DMA

Dallas Museum of Art Brings Together Major Works from Its Encyclopedic Collection to Explore Hope and Resilience in the Contemporary Moment. To Be Determined Features 13 New Acquisitions, Including New Work by Dallas Artists.

On September 27, the Dallas Museum of Art (DMA) will open To Be Determined, a new exhibition that brings together works from across the Museum's encyclopedic collection that, subject to viewer interpretation, reveal new meanings and take on heightened resonance in our current moment. Spanning seven centuries of media, geographies, cultures and perspectives, and featuring a new commission and new paintings by Dallas-based artists Jammie Holmes and Oshay Green, the works in To Be Determined are paired and grouped in unexpected ways, drawing evocative connections that resonate with present-day challenges—from isolation and loss, to the ongoing struggles against systemic racism and other forms of oppression—and offer sentiments of hope and resilience.

The result of a collaboration across the DMA's entire 12-person curatorial team, To Be Determined includes sacred objects and works of art and design from the 13th century to today by a wide-ranging group of artists including Frederic Edwin Church, David Alfaro Siqueiros, Mel Bochner, Ida Ten Eyck O'Keeffe, Adam Pendleton, and Hiroshi Yoshida. In addition to the three new paintings by Jammie Holmes and Oshay Green, the exhibition also includes new and recent acquisitions by Ini Archibong, Thornton Dial, Jeffrey Gibson, Glenn Ligon, Isamu Noguchi, Lorna Simpson, Matthew Wong, Charles White, and more. To Be Determined will be on view September 27 through December 27, 2020, in the Museum's Chilton Galleries. Cherished Dallas Christmas Market Takes Shopping and Giving Online

The Chi Omega Christmas Market is known as the unofficial start of holiday shopping season in Dallas, with more than 300 merchants and small businesses offering artisan goodies and gifts and the entrance fees benefiting local nonprofits. That's not changing this year, but what is changing is its format: The beloved holiday tradition is going virtual.

The 12 Days of Chi Omega Christmas Virtual Market will take place online November 10-21, allowing supporters to shop from the safety of their own homes while giving back to some of North Texas' most deserving beneficiaries, whose important work has not halted during these difficult times.

"A virtual Chi Omega Christmas Market allows us to bring a new experience to shoppers this year, while continuing the rich tradition of spreading holiday cheer and raising critically important funds for this year's amazing beneficiaries — the true meaning for the market," says Jana Beth Eidson, who is co-chairing the event with her daughters Taylor Eidson Wood and Savannah Eidson Near. During its 43-year legacy, the market has given back more than \$9 million to 120 local nonprofits.

This year's beneficiaries include Bridge Breast Network, Braswell Child Development Center, CitySquare, DME Exchange of Dallas, Family Gateway, Grant Halliburton Foundation, Make-A-Wish of North Texas, Mi Escuelita Preschool, Mommies In Need, New Friends New Life, Our Friends Place, PediPlace, Scottish Rite Hospital for Children, and The Senior Source.

The First Call for Patrons tradition will also continue, letting shoppers who make a donation shop the market a full day prior to the event's official start.

The first Chi Omega Christmas Market started in 1978 at the NorthPark Inn with fewer than 50 merchant booths and raised \$13,150 for the Dallas community.
